### Wine and Dine in Bangkok



# PATTANI, THE SOUTHERN CHARMS OF THAILAND



Pattani is one of the southern provinces of Thailand. Neighboring provinces are (from southeast clockwise) Narathiwat, Yala, and Songkhla. Pattani is basically a gem, with lots of halal food choices and wonderful seaside view.

Pattani still maintains the ruins of an ancient town in Amphoe Yarang that once served as an important port and centre of administration, trade, and Culture for many centuries. It has outstanding cultural places such as Krue Se Mosque, Lim Kor Niao Shrine, and beautiful natural features including forests, rivers, and seas.



#### **KRUE SE MOSQUE (MASJID KERISIK)**

Krue Se Mosque (Masjid Kerisik in Malay) was named after the Ban Krue Se (Kampung Kerisik). The mosque was designated a historical site by the Department of Fine Arts of Thailand in 1935. A mosque was known to have been constructed by the early 17th century, with the architectural style of the mosque of Arab-Persian-Turkish architecture.

#### **PATTANI SKYWALK**

Pattani Skywalk is a floating walkway that is more than 300 meters long. There is a beautiful view of the lake and the city of Pattani. You can walk floating along the walkway or if you want to challenge yourself, you can also float the water from the beginning to the end. Here you will experience the adventure and get to know the amazing natural resources of Pattani.



#### TALO KAPO BEACH

Talo Kapo Beach is a beautiful and quiet white sand beach. Located in Taloka Bay in the southern lake of the country. Here you can relax in the quiet atmosphere of the lake and the surrounding nature. Talo Kapo Beach also has an area that is suitable for playing water sports and other water activities, such as enjoying boating and diving.



#### CHAO MAE LIM KO NIAO SHRINE

# SPICE UP YOUR PALATE: PHANAENG CURRY

"Phanaeng Curry" is a popular Thai curry dish known for its rich and flavourful taste. It's similar to red curry but tends to be milder and sweeter. The dish typically includes coconut milk, red chili paste, kaffir lime leaves, Thai basil, and various proteins like chicken, beef, or shrimp.

Here's a simple recipe for making Beef Phanaeng Curry:

### Ingredients:

- Panang Curry Paste or Red Curry Paste
- Coconut Milk 400 g
- Beef Rump 300 g
- Rice Bran Oil 1tbsp
- Palm Sugar 30 g
- Fish Sauce 2 tsp
- Salt ½ tsp
- Pea Eggplant 40 g
- Kaffir Lime Leaf 3-4
- For garnish
- Kaffir Lime Leaf (sliced)
- Red Chilli (diagonal cut)
- Sweet Basil leaves

### Instructions:

- 1. Cut beef into thick slices.
- 2. Cook Phanaeng curry paste with half of the coconut milk until fragrant, stir until combined before adding beef slices and the rest of the coconut milk.
- 3. Add palm sugar, fish sauce and salt.
- 4. Once the curry is boiling, add pea eggplant and simmer until softened and the curry reduce and thicken a little.
- 5. Add red chilli, kaffir lime leaf (tear by hand), stir to combined and transfer to a serving bowl. Garnish with sliced kaffir lime leaves and sweet basil.

Serve the Phanaeng Curry over rice and enjoy!
