


Tips:

Familiarize yourself with the correct etiquette for various modes of travel to ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience.







For incoming and outgoing travellers passing through from 1 November 2023 to 30 April 2024. Thailand is temporarily suspending the need to fill out the 'To Mo 6' (TM6) immigration form for travellers entering and exiting Thailand at the Sadao Immigration Checkpoint in Songkhla starting from 1 November 2023 until 30 April 2024.
