




📍 Bangkok





With scenic viewpoints, waterfalls, and rich local culture such as Nora dance, Phatthalung is perfect for travelers seeking nature, culture, and a peaceful escape. Here are must-do activities while in Phatthalung, Thailand – great for nature, culture, viewpoints, and local experiences.



### Samphao Thai

Samphao Thai, Phatthalung is a tourist attraction often featuring scenic, agricultural-themed, and local inspired settings near Thale Noi Bird Watching Park.
