

SPICE UP YOUR PALATE: CHICKEN PAD KAPRAO

Pad Kaprao, is a popular and flavorful Thai dish known for its aromatic blend of basil, garlic, chili, and savory sauce. It is often made with minced meat, such as chicken, pork, or beef, and served over rice. The dish is commonly topped with a fried egg and accompanied by sliced cucumbers.


Here's a basic recipe for Pad Kaprao: Ingredients:

- 1 lb (450g) ground chicken (or your choice of meat)
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 3-5 Thai bird chilies, chopped (adjust according to spice preference)
- 2 cups Thai holy basil leaves (or substitute with sweet basil if unavailable)
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1 teaspoon sugar
- 1 tablespoon fish sauce
- Cooked jasmine rice, for serving
- Fried eggs, for serving (optional)

Instructions:

- Heat vegetable oil in a wok or large skillet over medium-high heat.
- Add minced garlic and chopped Thai bird chilies to the hot oil. Stir-fry for about 30 seconds until fragrant.
- Add ground chicken to the wok and break it up with a spatula. Cook until the chicken is browned and cooked through.
- Add soy sauce, sugar, and fish sauce, over the chicken and stir to combine.
- Taste and adjust the seasoning if needed. If you prefer it spicier, you can add more chopped chilies.
- Under low heat, add the basil leaves and stir-fry a few times.
- Serve the Pad Kra Pao over cooked jasmine rice. Optionally, top with a fried egg and serve with sliced cucumbers on the side.

Enjoy this delicious and aromatic Thai dish!

- Enhanced Security: Our QR code payment system prioritizes the security of financial transactions, hence Malaysian tourists can enjoy peace of mind.


The service providers offering this cross-border QR payment service to their customers via their mobile payment applications include participating service providers from Malaysia and commercial banks from Thailand.
