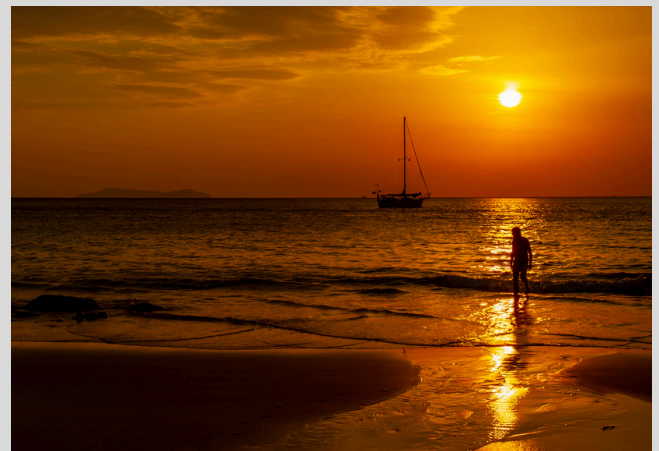
Jurassic World: Rebirth (2025)

Four Seasons Resort, Koh Samui

Opened in 2007, this five-star establishment covers over 40 acres of former coconut plantation (retaining 856 coconut trees on its grounds) on the island's north-western tip. It is built into the hillside, giving spectacular views of the Gulf of Siam.



Wat Pu Khao Thong, Koh Samui

As the characters in the series explore the destination and what's around them, they visit this most intriguing temple. The ornately decorated exterior of this small building and the Buddha inside were filmed as they appear in real life.

1. Massaman Curry

In Thai food context, this curry are thicker and richer than red curry or green curry and unique in flavors more reminiscent of Indian curries. Popular in southern Thailand and believed to have come through with Malay people, Massaman curry is considered a Muslim-Thai food.

2. Tom Yum Goong

The ever popular spicy and sour prawn soup, Tom Yum Goong are everybody's favorite soup. Easily available in any part of Thailand, Tom Yum Goong maybe the healthiest Thai dish with low calories!

3. Gaeng Kaew Wan Gai

This Thai Green Curry is a fragrant, spicy, creamy, and sweet dish, often made with chicken, eggplant, and snow peas, and typically eaten with rice as full meal.



4. Pad Krapow Gai

This dish simply know as Thai basil chicken is a stir-fry dish made with finely chopped or ground chicken cooked with chile peppers, garlic, and shallot. It's a classic Thai dish and can be found in restaurants and as a popular street food.
