## AKHA SWING FESTIVAL 2025 CELEBRATES HILL TRIBE TRADITIONS IN CHIANG RAI

Come and join us to experience one of Chiang Rai's most vibrant ethnic celebrations — the Akha Swing Festival 2025. This cultural event offers a rare opportunity to witness the living heritage of the Akha hill tribe, celebrated only once a year in various communities across Chiang Rai.

The Akha Swing Festival marks the Akha New Year and honours E-Um Sa Yae, the goddess believed to bring abundance to crops and the land. It also reflects the Akha people's deep respect for women — Akha women prepare ornate traditional dress months in advance, worn especially for this festival. At the heart of the celebration is the swing itself, built from large wooden beams and used in symbolic rites and festive games.

The events are scheduled from 4 to 8 September at Ban Phahee, Mae Sai District, and from 6 to 8 September at Ban Pha Mee, Mae Sai District.



#### THE CHARACTERISTICS OF THAI FOOD

Thai cuisine is known for its aromatic flavors, balanced combination of sweet, sour, salty, and spicy tastes, and emphasis on lightly prepared dishes. Key dishes include the stir-fried noodles such as Pad Thai, the ever-popular hot and sour Tom Yum soup, the rich coconut-based Tom Kha Gai, and various curries like Green Curry and Massaman Curry. Other popular dishes are Som Tam (green papaya salad) and Khao Soi (Northern Thai noodle dish).

Rice, particularly jasmine rice, is an essential component of Thai meals, often served with soups, curries, and other side dishes.
