Test & Go



THAILAND PASS

- Apply for Thailand Pass QR Code anytime 60 days in advance of travel plans
- Wait for approval of Vaccine Certification, paid accommodation including RT-PCR
- Receive Thailand Pass QR Code upon Confirmation of Approval





VACCINATION

- Travelers from all countries
- Fully vaccinated with an approved vaccine at least 14 days before traveling
- No more than 72 hours RT-PCR test with a negative result










PAID ACCOMODATION

- Confirmed payment for Day 1 & 5 stay at SHA Extra Plus or AQ
- Paid RT-PCR tests for Day 1 & 5
- Prearranged transfer from airport to hotel





INSURANCE

- An insurance policy with coverage no less than USD50,000
- In case of a positive case, the expenses of hospital/home isolation must be covered by the traveler

MORCHANA APP

- Download and install the Mor-Chana App at the hotel, available for Android on Play Store and iOS on the App Store
- · Set it on at all time



ARRIVAL IN THAILAND


- Present Thailand Pass QR Code and necessary documents to Health Control and proceed for Immigration procedures
- Undergo the RT-PCR test at the pre-arranged test centre
- Proceed to the hotel by pre-arranged transfer (distance from airport within 5 hours)



DURING STAY IN THAILAND



- Wait for the test result for Day 1 and Day 5 at the hotel. Tourists only need to be in isolation/quarantine on Day 1 and Day 5 while waiting for RT-PCR results to be proven negative. On Days 2, 3, 4 tourists can go on with visiting/holiday activities.
- For short stay visitors (ie. 5 days), Day 5 quarantine is not applicable.
- MorChana App will alert RT-PCR test on Day 5
- Undergo RT-PCR test at the pre-arranged test centre

Meanwhile, in Udon Thani to the upper northeast, their famous Red Lotus Lake is also in full bloom, painting the whole area red, literally.



BANPOT WITTAYA SCHOOL, CHIANG RAI

Banpot Wittaya School in Chiang Rai is one of the best places to enjoy the stunning Sakura-like blooming blossom during the cool season in the north of Thailand. Located in Wiang Kaen District, this scene is about 2 hours journey from the city of Chiang Rai.



Red Lotus Lake, Udon Thani

Red Lotus Lake or Talay Bua Daeng is located near the city of Udon Thani. This popular lake is known for morning boat tours to view blooming pink water lilies, which is the best visit from October to February.

nu Lom Lo is located in Loei, the upper I-san, a mountain on the border of three provinces namely Pitsanulok, Petcl boon, and Loei. During the cold season, the mountains of Phu Lom Lo are turning pink due to the blossoming of Wi imalayan Cherry flowers.
