Songkran Festival - Happy Thai New Year

Come April it will be the Thai New Year and as usual, you can expect a roaring good and wet time as the Songkran Festival kicks in. It is the traditional Thai New Year and is celebrated every April 13, 14, and 15 nationwide. It is a combination of Thai New Year, Family Day, and National Elderly Day.

This festival is the time for family reunions at which family members get together and make merit at temples, culminating in the Songkran or water festival that had gained popularity among visitors to Thailand. Most of the activities during Songkran involve water, as the underlying significance of this festival is the process of cleansing and purifying one's self before starting the new year.

With the easing rules to enter Thailand, tourists are welcome to hop over to any part of Thailand to enjoy and celebrate the festivities.

During this pandemic, measures have been taken to reduce the risk of infections dur-

- Water splashing and traditional activities such as "Rod nam dam hua" are allowed to be held
 in line with the Covid Free Setting measures.
- Water splashing is Not Allowed in public areas such as roads.
- Those who attended the celebration in a closed space must maintain the SOP such as wearing masks and social distancing.



Procedures to Enter Thailand


Starting from April 1, 2022, Thailand is opening for land travel through border checkpoints- Nong Khai, Udon Thani, Songkhla, and Satun. Meanwhile, the number of approved airports are - Don Mueang, Suvarnabhumi, Phuket, Krabi, Samui, Chiang Mai, U-Tapao, and Hat Yai.

Let it Go






KARON BEACH, PHUKET
