Thailand Reopening takes further steps this November by planning to open a few more provinces to push tourism recovery in the country forward. Famous tourist destinations in Thailand will reopen this coming November, which are Hua Hin, Chiang Mai, and Pattaya.

Visit the Maruekhathaiyawan Palace Built-in the 1920s entirely out of teak wood, it is situated right on the beach and was a summer retreat or King Vajiravudh (Rama VI).










Amazing Thailand 7+7 Webinar
