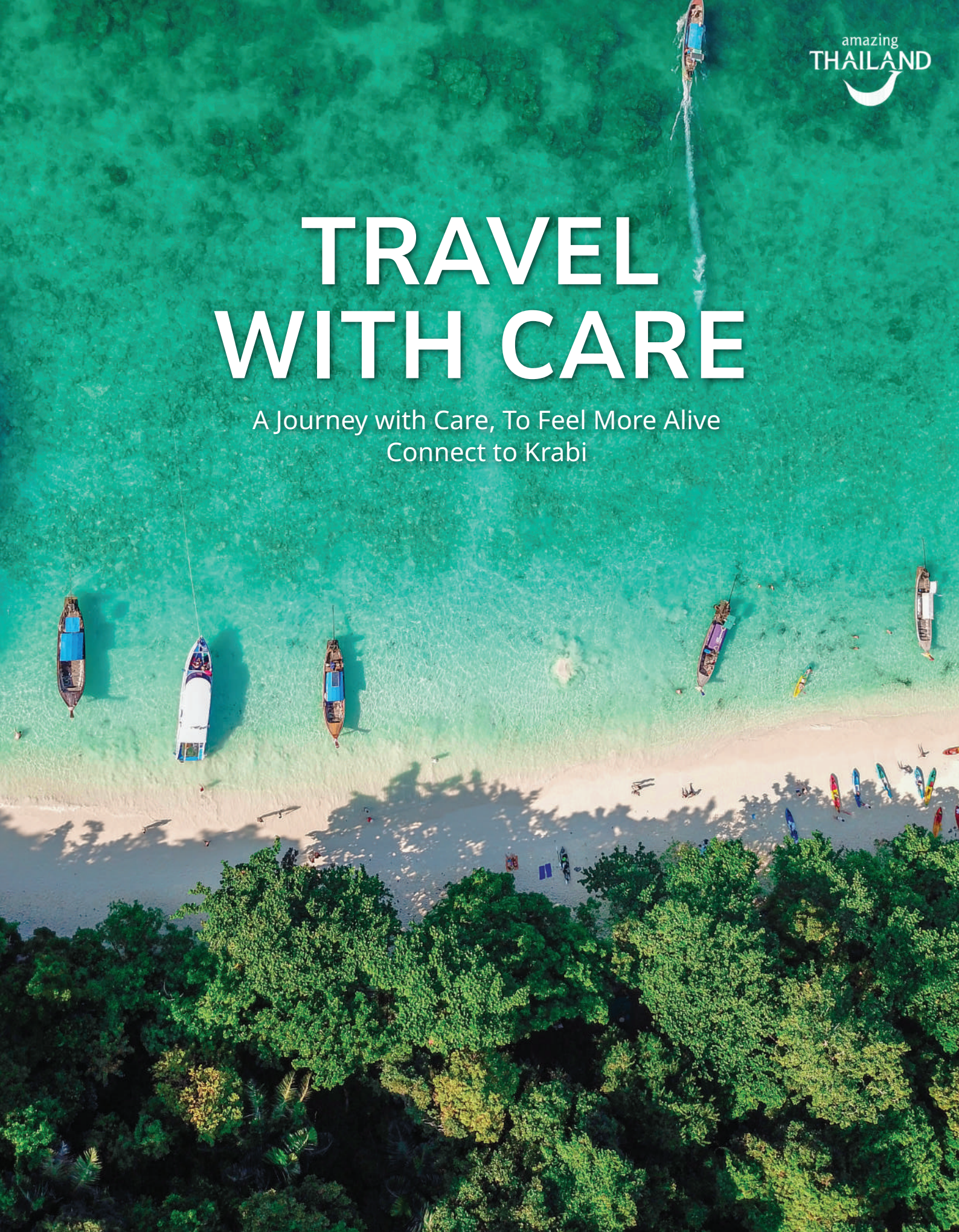

It is not merely exercise, but a journey to listen to the voice of nature within the forest, and to listen to your own inner voice amid the powerful silence.

Therefore, the Rebirth and Refuel trail is not just a ‘walking path’ But a journey of the heart, guiding you back to yourself and helping you rediscover who you are, while leaving no trace in nature except calm and simple footprints.

Trails at Khao Phanom Bencha National Park

Khao Phanom Bencha National Park offers two trails that draw you deep into its lush wilderness. The first leads to Huai Sa Kae Waterfall, a two-hour trek through evergreen forest where sunlight filters through tall canopies and a century-old Sam Phong tree stands in quiet majesty.

The second, a gentle 2-kilometer loop, circles the mountain before arriving at the refreshing Huai To Waterfall. Both paths invite you to slow down, listen to the forest, and discover its hidden stories among rare plants and birdsong.

DAY 1 Khao Phanom Bencha Trail

Khao Phanom Bencha National Park is home to a high mountain peak covered in dense forest, spanning Mueang Krabi District, Ao Luek District, and Khao Phanom District. The forest remains largely pristine, with streams, waterfalls, woodlands, and a wide variety of wildlife. The natural park is especially rich in birdlife, with more than 218 species recorded. Huai To Waterfall is located about 500 meters from the park's office, originating from Khao Phanom Bencha. It has 11 tiers, with some drops around 70–80 meters high, and natural pools suitable for swimming. Huai Sakae Waterfall is about 1.2 kilometers from the park's office, cascading from a cliff in 3 tiers, with clear pools of water. The summit of Khao Phanom Bencha is a sought-after destination for hikers, with two trails leading to the peak. Along the way, trekkers can experience stunning natural scenery, including diverse plant species, wildlife, caves, waterfalls, streams, sea mist, and viewpoints overlooking Krabi town, with cool, pleasant weather year-round.

- Begin with a nature trail to see the majestic Sompong Phueng Luang tree (*Tetrameles nudiflora* R.Br.), a heritage tree of Khao Phanom Bencha Forest, standing tall within Khao Phanom Bencha National Park, Krabi. This impressive tree has a trunk circumference of about 35 meters—roughly the span of 30 people linking arms—and rises more than 30 meters high, equivalent to a 10-story building. Estimated to be around 120 years old, it is considered a heritage tree of great value, symbolizing the richness of Khao Phanom Bencha Forest.
- Continue to visit Huai To Waterfall, an 'Unseen Krabi' Wonder known for its pristine natural waters, where visitors can swim and enjoy the lush, shaded surroundings. Walk another 700 meters further, and you'll discover the serene and beautiful Huai Sakae Waterfall.

The province naturally boasts stunning seas and forests, is home to one of only five saline hot springs in the world, and has been recognized as a sustainable tourism destination, making the Green Destinations Top 100 Stories in 2023.

The focus goes beyond mere relaxation, fostering a mindful connection between guests, nature, and the environment. 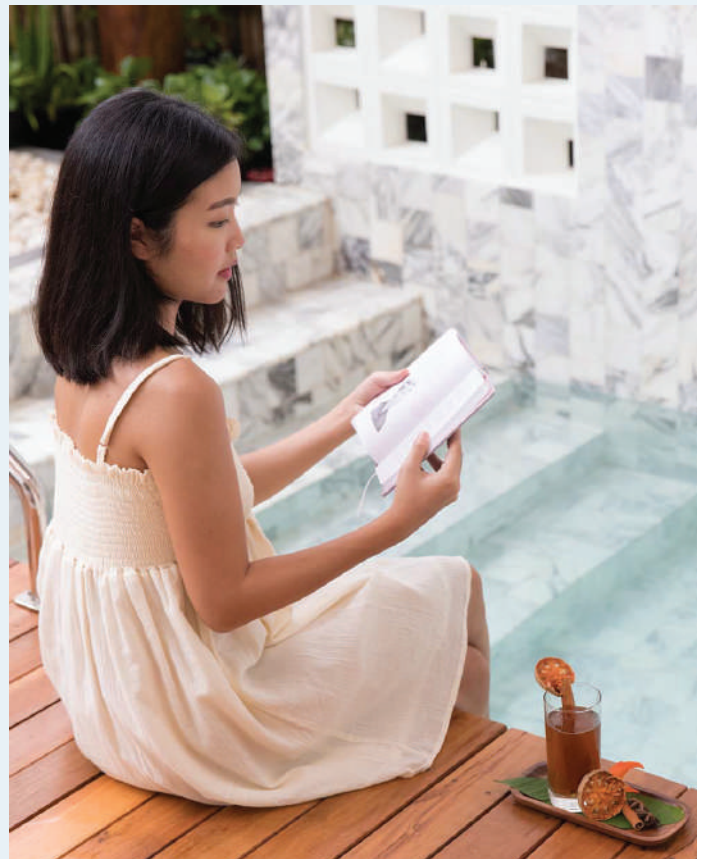

These establishments still cook with heart, using locally sourced ingredients and, importantly, recipes and stories passed down in each dish.

From time-honored Mee Hoon Kadook Moo (pork bone rice noodles), traditional Muslim Roti Cha-Chak (a plate of hot Roti served with a glass of sweet, creamy, frothy milk tea), handmade ancient Khanom Pia (Chinese-style, mooncake-like pastries), to locally grown spices, you can experience the stories of a simple way of life that still endures. 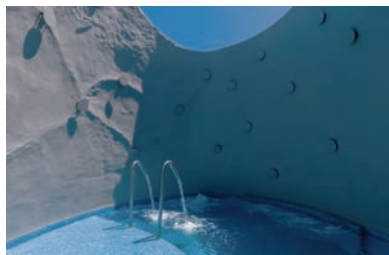

At the Dragon's Crest Summit Viewpoint, which rises about 500 meters above sea level, you'll be rewarded with sweeping panoramas of Krabi's stunning turquoise sea, scattered islands, and iconic limestone mountains stretching across the Andaman Sea, making it a spectacular spot for sunrise and sunset. This trail leaves a truly unforgettable experience on every traveler no less than any other place.
